CURRIE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT FACILITY UPGRADES (SP03)

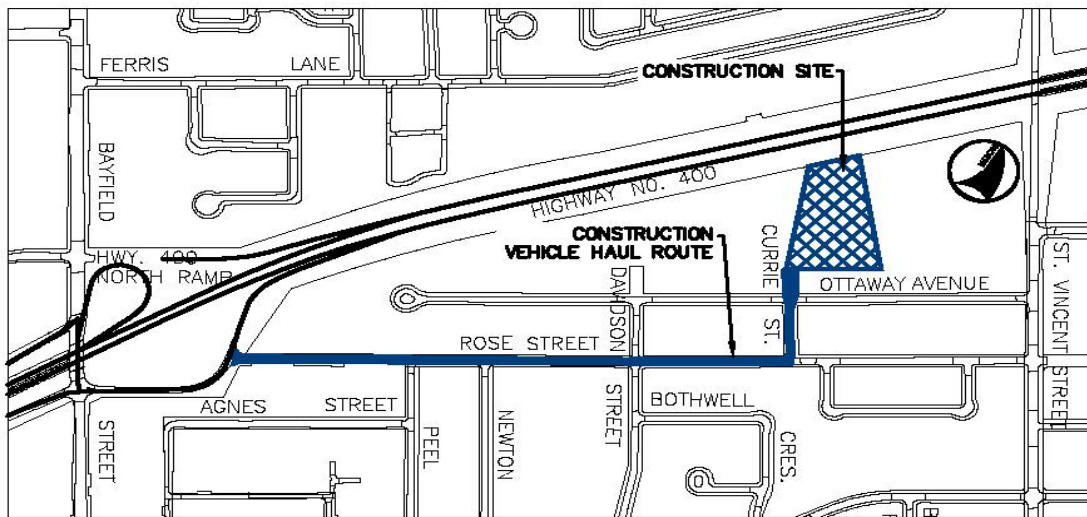

The City of Barrie is upgrading the existing Currie Stormwater Management Facility. The upgrades will increase the size of the existing Stormwater Management Facility and convert it from a dry pond to a wet pond. This work is part of the Sophia Creek Watershed & Mulcaster Drainage Area Class EA Update (2017), to improve system and environmental performance.

MAP OF THE WORK AREA








WORK DETAILS

The City's contractor will:

- Install new stormwater sewers around the pond, including an oil and grit separator to treat some of the runoff from 28 Currie Street,
- Restoration and rehabilitation of the existing watercourse adjacent to the new wet pond facility,
- Excavate and construct a new forebay including a large armourstone inlet,
- Reconstruct the existing pond including a new outlet,
- Construct a new access road for pond maintenance and,
- Create naturalization of the site through landscape planting of trees, shrubs, and seeding native grasses and wildflowers.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

You may experience dust, noise, and other inconveniences. The City will make efforts to reduce these impacts and your patience is appreciated.

	<p>Pre-Condition Survey: The Contractor has retained OZA Inspections Limited to complete a precondition survey of the exterior and interior of homes and businesses immediately adjacent to the project site. A separate letter will be provided to the owners of the affected properties by the survey company.</p>
	<p>Road and Sidewalk Access: Pedestrian access will be maintained during construction. Access into 28 Currie Street will be maintained throughout the duration of this project. During the construction, short delays while driving through are expected when equipment is maneuvering, trucks are dumping, etc. We ask for your patience in such instances.</p>
	<p>Services: Your sanitary sewer, hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen circumstances. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>
	<p>Traffic Management: The project requires a large quantity of existing materials to be excavated and removed from site. Adjacent residents on Rose Street, between Currie Street and Bayfield Street, will see an increase in heavy truck traffic during the construction period. The Contractor will take measures to keep the truck traffic to a minimum, including using a designated queueing location for vehicles waiting to enter the site. All construction activities will occur within the site limits and there is no anticipated impact to traffic.</p>
	<p>Safety: The Contractor is required to conduct their work in a safe manner, including fencing of deep excavations, etc. We ask that you take extra caution during the construction period to ensure everyone's safety.</p>
