

Big Bay Point Road – Painswick Bridge ‘B’ Rehabilitation

December 2022

The City of Barrie has awarded Contract 2022-151T for the **Big Bay Point Road Painswick Bridge ‘B’ Rehabilitation** between Ashford Drive and Pine Drive to Clearwater Structures Inc. Construction will take place from **January 2023 to Fall 2023**. We appreciate your patience as we revitalize this important transportation link.



Please note that only the westbound bridge will be under construction.

Traffic Impacts

Driver's and pedestrians can expect to have minor delays during Construction.

- A single lane of traffic will be open to traffic in each direction.
- The bridge will be fully closed during construction and westbound traffic shifted into an eastbound lane.
- The south sidewalk adjacent to Painswick Park will remain open with the north sidewalk will being closed.
- The contractor will have access across the open south sidewalk to bring in equipment and materials for construction work below the bridge.

Work Performed

The work will include the following:

- Removals of existing asphalt, deck and end joint assemblies, approach slabs, sidewalks, concrete sections from abutments, wing walls, and piers;
- Repairs to abutments, wing walls, piers, approach and sleeper slabs, soffit, and modified deck ends;
- General earthwork construction including excavation and backfill operations;
- Structural upgrading of steel reinforcements and conventional expansion joints;
- Deck waterproofing and new pavement

Timing

Works are scheduled to begin under the bridge Winter 2023. The majority of Traffic Impacts should be from Spring to Fall 2023.

Impacts to Residents and Schools

Hydro, telephone, cable TV, and gas services should not be affected by the construction, barring any unforeseen events. As per normal construction practices, minor noise, dust, and lighting impacts are anticipated. Minor traffic impacts are also anticipated (see Traffic Impacts). Pedestrian access will be signed along with pedestrian crossings at intersections.

Pre-Condition Surveys

Pre-Condition surveys will be completed by OZA Inspections Ltd. for properties immediately surrounding the construction area December 2022.

Will Metrolinx Service Be Impacted?

The Construction will not impact Metrolinx train schedules barring unforeseen circumstances.



Painswick Park Construction
